## WHAT IS A MEDICAL HOME?

A medical home is not a building or a place but is a name for the way a primary care medical clinic cares for you that puts YOU at the center of your health care.

A medical home care team includes everyone at a medical home clinic such as the check in staff, nurses, and the medical home health care provider. A medical home health care provider is a doctor, physician assistant, or nurse practitioner that cares for patients in a medical home setting. Your medical home health care provider supervises your health care and works with the care team at your medical home. If needed, they coordinate teams of other healthcare workers (for example, specialist doctors, pharmacists, and hospitals) that help take care of you. Your medical home care team will help to make sure your medical care is given in the right place, at the right time, and in a way that is best for you.

It's never too early or too late to take control of your health. Make going to recommended medical visits a habit. Even if you have a specialist medical clinic that you go to regularly make sure to go to your medical home so they can coordinate your care. If you have an acute health need, sudden flu symptoms, back pain, an unexpected rash, who is your first point of contact? Your medical home team will provide contact information to get in touch with them 24/7 and they are the right first step for most healthcare problems.
